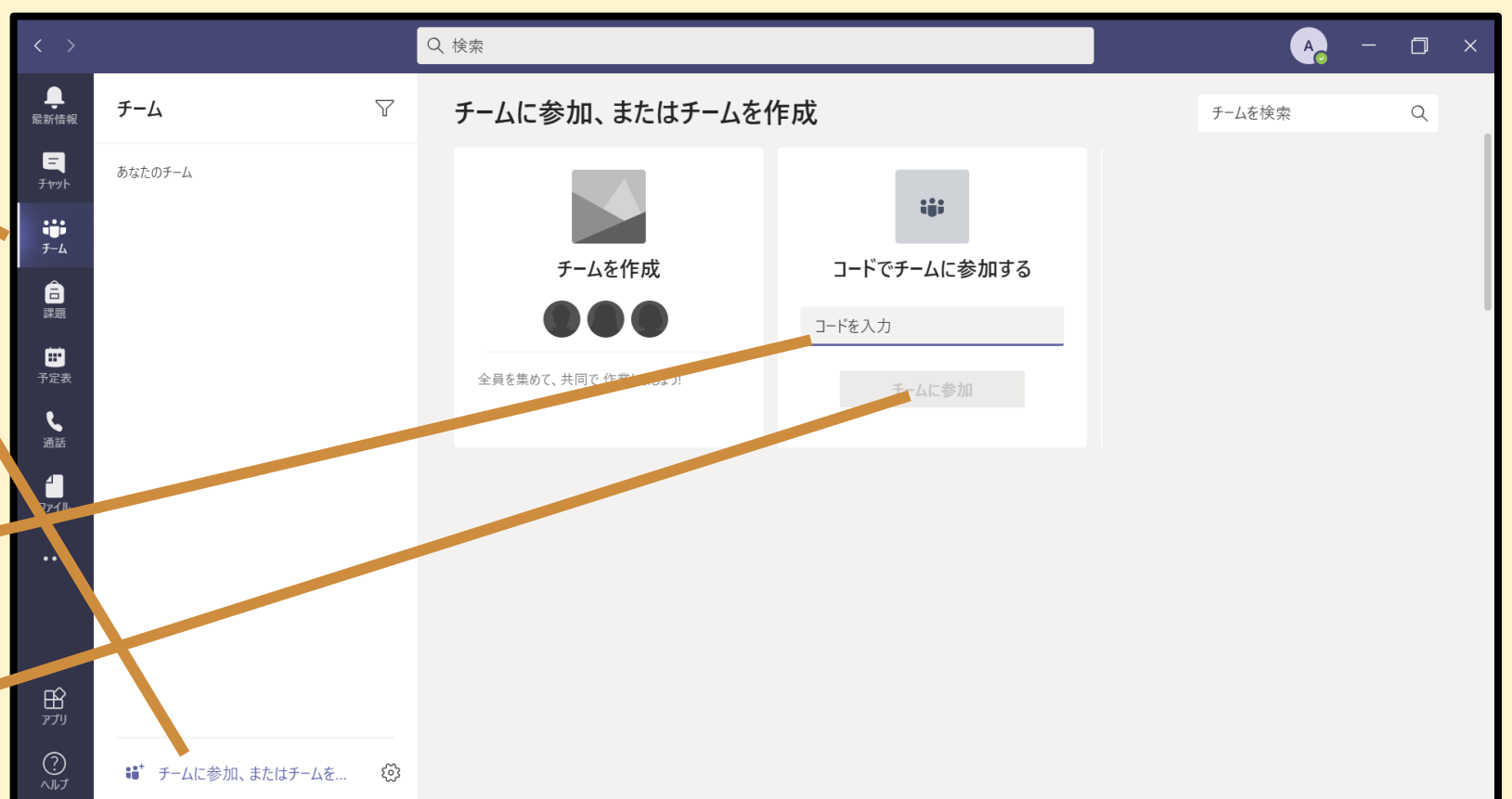
4. How to join
