(2) Check your temperature before you enter the room. If you have a temperature of 37.5 or above, you cannot use the room.

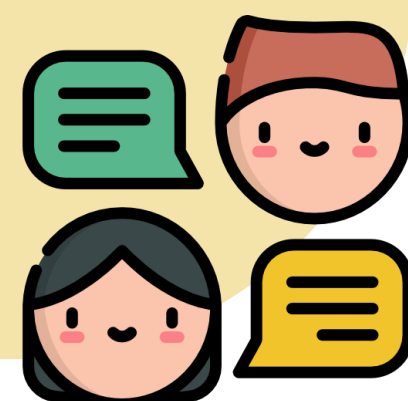
(3) No food or drink in the room.
